Method and duration of entry period

Method of entry

Entry is open to respondents of the Western Australia Student Satisfaction Survey 2023. Respondents under the age of 18 years, and respondents who complete the hardcopy survey are not eligible to enter the prize draws.

Entry into the First Prize Draw is open to all those who complete the survey online or by telephone by midnight Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) Sunday 8 October 2023.

Entry into the Second Prize Draw is open to all those who complete the survey by midnight AWST Sunday 22 October 2023.

Entry into the Third Prize Draw is open to all those who complete the survey by midnight AWST Sunday 5 November 2023.

Duration of entry period

The entry period for inclusion in the First Prize Draw is from 13 September 2023 until midnight Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) Sunday 8 October 2023.

The entry period for inclusion in the Second Prize Draw is from 13 September 2023 until midnight AWST Sunday 22 October 2023.

The entry period for inclusion in the Third Prize Draw is from 14 September 2023 until midnight AWST Sunday 5 November 2023.

Details of prizes and prize values

The total value of the prize pool across all three draws is \$2,750.

Prize Draw 1

Date, time and place of draw

Winners will be identified through a random computer-generated draw.

Cancellation/modify clause

If for any reason any aspect of these prize draws are not capable of running as planned, including by reason of computer virus, communications network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of Wallis Social Research, Wallis Social Research will contact the WA Gaming and Wagering Commission ('the Commission') to seek written approval to cancel, postpone or modify the prize draw(s). Wallis Social Research will then notify eligible and affected survey respondents of the change by email, or phone if a valid email address is not available.

Publication of winner names
